



AIRPLANE FIRST-AID KIT

In each CCA fleet airplane, you will find a blue first-aid kit in the baggage area. The first-aid kit must be changed after 5 years from install or 30 days from the seal being broken. The kit includes routine first aid and immediate trauma medical supplies. It is imperative that the Pilot-In-Command become familiar with the contents of the kit and how to use them. The following are the contents:

Medicine and Antiseptics

- 2 Ibuprofen Tablets
- 2 Extra-Strength Non-Aspirin
- 2 Antibiotic ointment packs
- 10 Alcohol cleaning pads
- 9 BZK antiseptic towelettes

Bandages

- 50 plastic bandages, ¾"x3"
- 10 plastic bandages, 1"x3"
- 2 Elbow & knee plastic bandages, 2"x4"
- 5 Junior Plastic bandages, 3/8"x 1-1/2"
- 1 Knuckle fabric bandage
- 2 patch bandages, 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"

Dressings

- 1 instant cold compress
- 2 butterfly wound closures
- 1 finger splint 6"x3/4"
- 1 First aid tape roll, ½" x 5yd.

Injury Treatment

- 1 Trauma pad, 5"x9"
- 1 Sterile eye pad
- 8 gauze dressing pads, 2"x2"
- 2 gauze dressing pads, 3"x3"

Reference and Instruments

- 2 Nitrile exam gloves
- 1 Tweezer, plastic
- 1 Medium safety pin
- 10 cotton-tipped applicators, 3"
- 1 Durable clear-pocket soft pack
- 1 American Red-Cross first aid Guide
